Scholarship winners will be determined by: 70% Essay/Video, 10% Community Service, 10% Extracurricular Activities and 10% GPA. Students with the responsibility of paid employment will have that time considered as Activities. Winners will be notified by phone or email, and will receive their award at our Annual Meeting May 22nd in the Solvay Branch at 5:15 p.m.
